Elgin, IL – Renz Addiction Counseling Center was recently awarded \$1,000 from the Kiwanis Club of Elgin to help fund All Stars, a youth prevention education program at Kimball and Abbott Middle Schools. All Stars is a school-based program designed to delay and prevent high-risk behaviors in middle school-age youth, including substance use, violence, and premature sexual activity.
